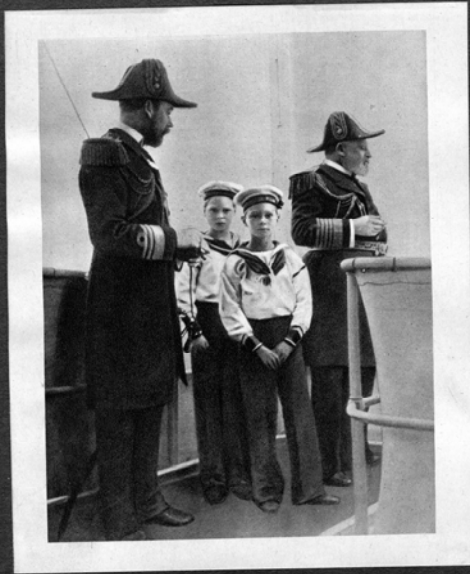

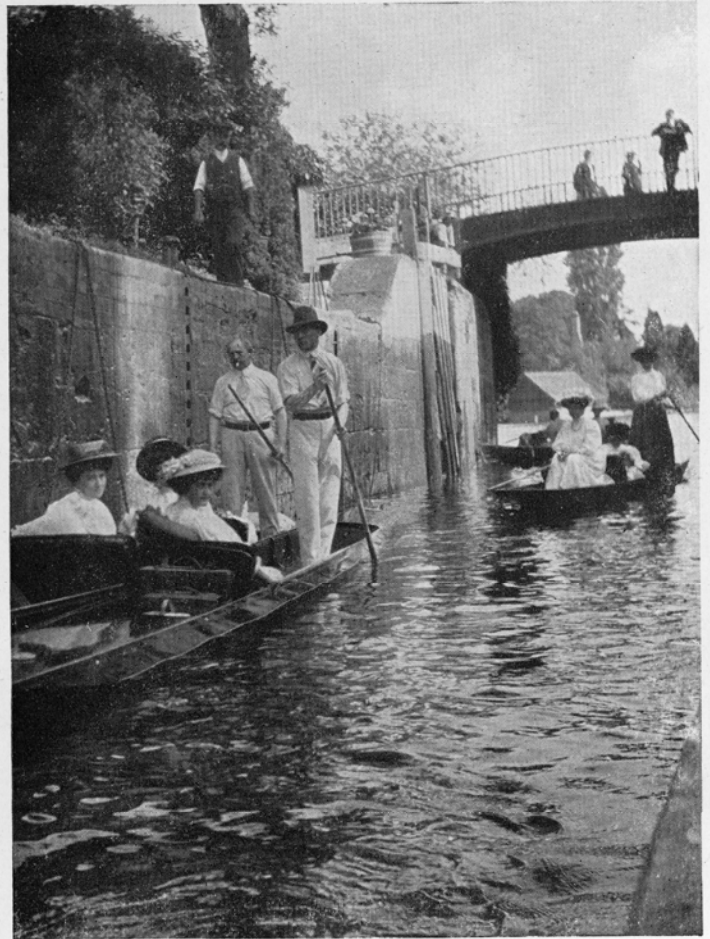

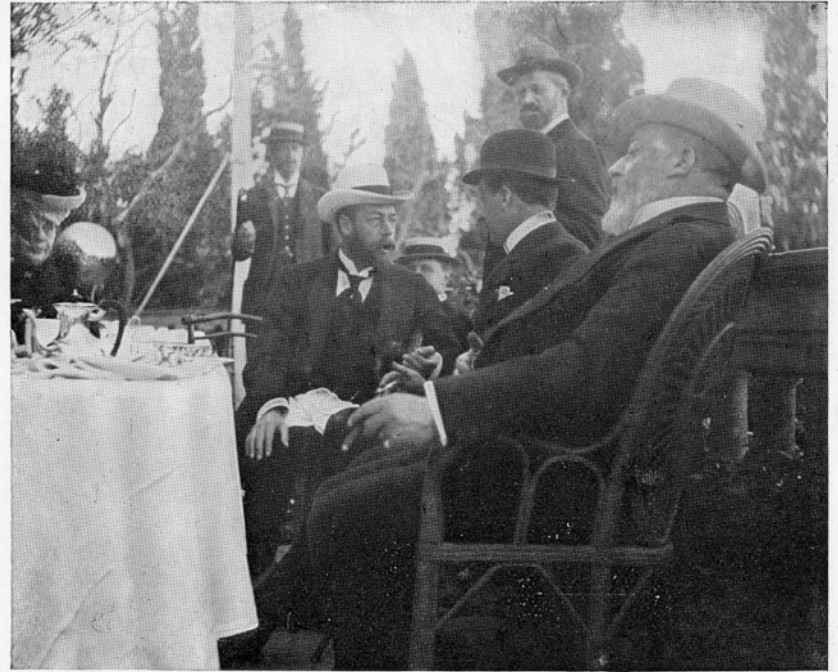

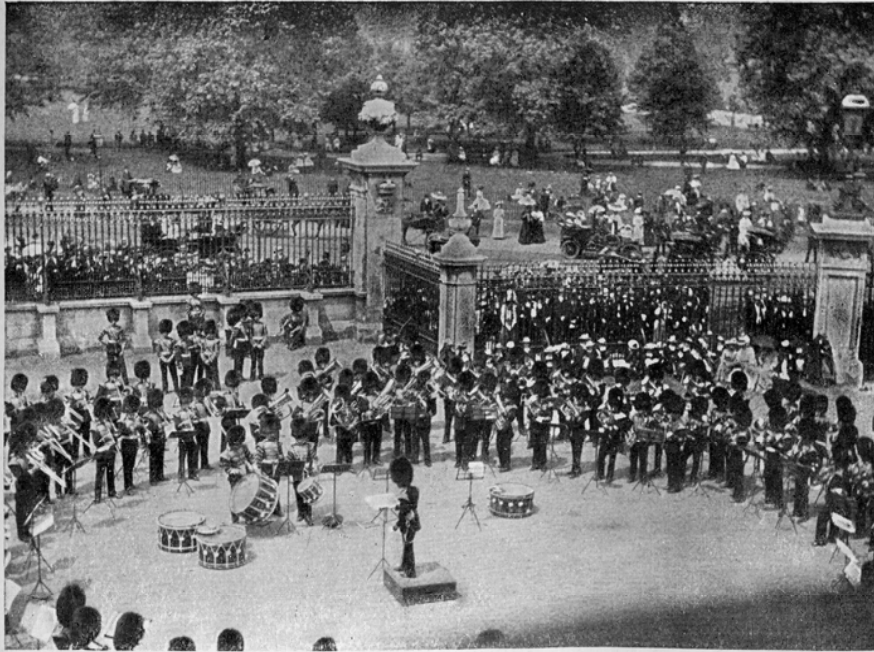

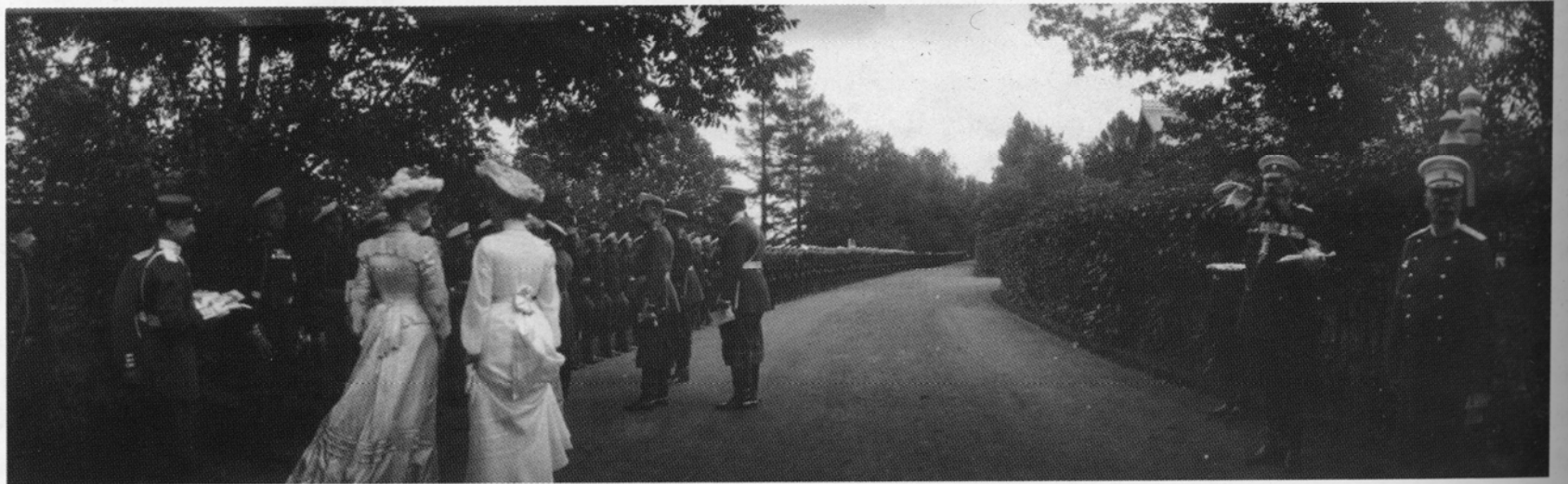
The Thames—Boulter's Lock.

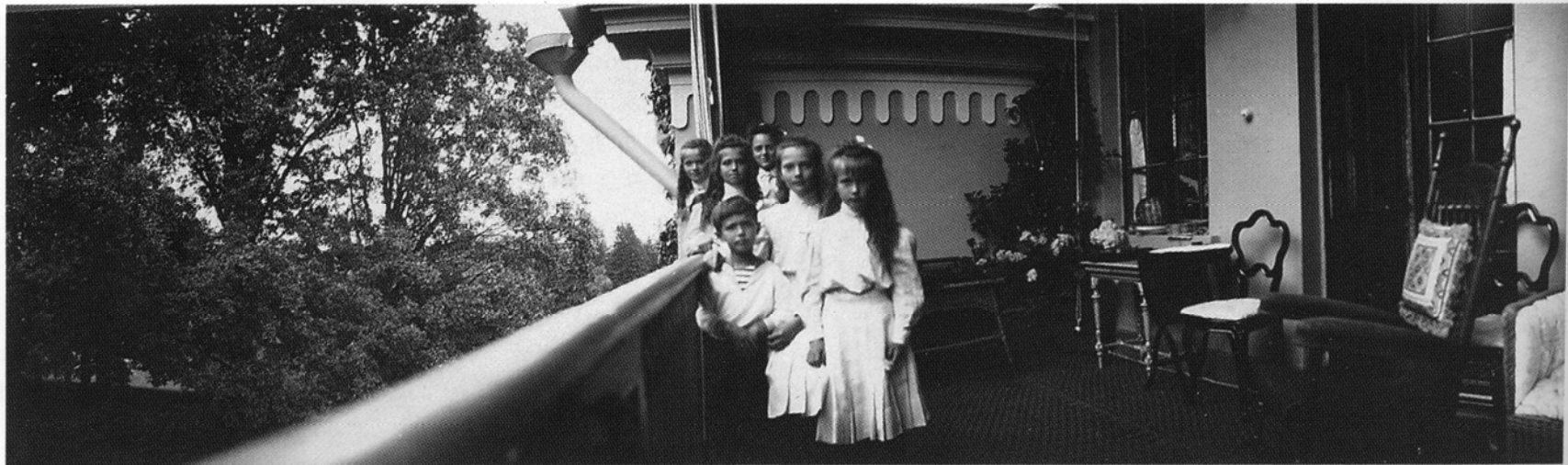
