#### What is stress?

- volume
- •pitch
- ·length
- vowel quality

### Levels of stress

- •strongly stressed (primary)
- ·lightly stressed (secondary)
- unstressed (weak or no)

e.g. Jàpanése Japanese JAPanESE /dʒæpəˈniyz/

# Compare stress patterns:

French économique organisation English economic organization

#### Where is the stress?

#### 2-SYLLABLE WORDS-usually on the first syllable

•German origin:

MOTHer WATer WISdom

Latin origin-tendency to move stress to 1st syllable:

MUSic GRAMmar REAson

NOTE: Even stronger tendency in British English BAL•let/bal•LET GAR•age/ga•RAGE

BUT:

conTAIN beLIEF dePEND WHY?

#### **PREFIXES**

•German origin:

a-, be-, for-, fore-, mis-, out-, over-, un-, under-, up-, with-

Verbs-stressed on base/root unTIE outRUN overDO underSTAND

Nouns-stressed on prefix
FOREsight OUTcome Overdose UNderwear

#### Compare:

There was an Overload of electricity on the circuit.

Don't overLOAD the circuit!
