### Academic Language

There are several things to keep in mind when writing academic papers.

#### Avoid contractions:

Students who fail the exam **can't** enter the university. (no) Students who fail the exam **cannot** enter the university. (yes)

### Use formal register:

The government needs to **get rid of** the deficit. (no) The government needs to **eliminate** the deficit. (yes)

# Avoid "you"

There are several steps **you** can take to find housing. (no) There are several steps **students** can take to find housing. (yes)

### Use mid-position adverbs:

The molten steel is poured into the molds **slowly**. (no) The molten steel is **slowly** poured into the moulds. (yes)

#### Don't use "etc."

Writing well involves planning, drafting, editing, etc. (no) Writing well involves planning, drafting, and editing. (yes)

## Word Choice/Tone

Adjust the language to achieve an academic tone.

- 1. A huge number of people have been really upset with Bush over the events of the Iraqi war.
- 2. Rents have skyrocketed in the last couple of years and the situation isn't going to change for a while, probably.
- 3. Nobody was crazy about the drawings submitted for the World Trade Center site, so they kept the competition open a little bit longer.

- 4. We can solve the problem by just switching a few elements around.
- 5. The research proposal was turned down because the research would have required lots of money.
