

Situational Usage

1. Comment to your classmate that he is good at playing guitar. And, tell him that you want to learn (playing) guitar.

ギターを弾くのが上手ですね。ギターが習いたいです。

2. Tell your colleague that you wanted to stay at your friend's house when you were child on every Saturday.

子ども の時、毎週土曜日に 友達 の家に泊まりました。

3. Tell your colleague that you intend to go to Mr. Fuji next weekend because your friend wants to climb Mt. Fuji.

友達 が 富士山 に登りたがっているから、来週の週末 富士山 に行くつもりです。

4. Tell your colleague that you usually do such things as shopping and doing laundry on Monday.

たいてい月曜日に買い物したり洗濯したりします。

5. Ask your friend where she is coming from.

しゅっしん
出身はどこ？

6. You meet your acquaintance that you haven't seen for a long time. Greet him politely.

ひさ
久しぶりですね。

7. Tell your neighbor that you have met Mr. Bill Gates (ビル・ゲイツ) and he has told you that he likes baseball.

ビル・ゲイツに会ったことがあります。野球が好きだと言っていました。

8. Tell your classmate that you have never cut classes.

じゅぎょう
授業をサボったことはないよ。

9. Your friend invites you for dinner. She suggests Japanese food, but you had Japanese food for dinner last night. Tell her that you had sushi for dinner yesterday and suggest Italian food instead.

きのうばん はん
昨日 晩 ご飯にお寿司を食べたから、イタリア料理はどう？

10. Tell your neighbor that you drink tea and coffee, for example, but you don't drink Japanese tea.

こうちゃ
紅茶 やコーヒーは飲みますが、日本のお茶は飲みません。

11. Tell your friend that you bought just one T-shirt because you didn't have much money.

お金をあまり持っていなかったから、Tシャツを一枚だけ買いました。

12. You heard that your friend would go to Australia in July. Tell her that you have never been there and also want to go there.

オーストラリアに行ったことがないから、私も行きたい。

13. Tell your colleague that you think that Mr. Tanaka likes doing such things as going for a drive and singing karaoke on weekend.

田中さんは週末ドライブをしたり、カラオケをしたりするのが好きだと思います。

14. You were asked what you want to do during summer vacation. Tell your friend that you want to do such things like doing a part-time job and playing with friends.

アルバイトをしたり、^{ともだち}友達 ^{あそ}と遊んだりしたい。

15. Tell your colleague that Yamashita wanted to go dancing, but he didn't go because he had a lot of work.

山下さんは^{おど}踊りに行きたがっていましたが、たくさん仕事があったから、行きませんでした。

16. Ask your neighbor if he has had a fight with a friend.

^{ともだち}友達 とけんかをしたことがありますか。

17. You went to see a news movie on weekend. Tell your friend that it was so-so.

まあまあだったよ。

18. Tell your teacher that you are studying for about five hours every day because you want to be a president of a company in the future.

^{しょうらい}将来 社長になりたいから、毎日五時間ぐらい勉強しています。

19. Your acquaintance plans to go to Japan next year and asks you about Kyoto and Tokyo. Tell her that there are many famous temples in Kyoto, but there are not many in Tokyo.

^{きょうと}京都 ^{ゆうめい}にはたくさん有名 ^{てら}なお寺 がありますが、東京にはあまりありませんよ。

20. Your American friend asked you what he should bring when he visits people in Japan. Tell him that you think that things like sweets and fruits are good for souvenir.

おみやげには^{かし}お菓子 ^{くだもの}や果物 がいいと思うよ。

21. Ask your friend which is better between swimming in the lake and going art museum.

^{みずうみ}湖 ^{およ}で泳ぐのと ^{びじゅつかん}美術館 に行くのとどっちがいい？

22. Your teacher asked you what you want to do in the future. Tell her that you want to become either a singer or a actress in the future.

^{しょうらい}将来 ^{かしゅ}、歌手 ^{じょゆう}か女優 になりたいです。

23. Tell your child that he must not do things like telling a lie or cutting classes.

うそをついたり、^{じゅぎょう}授業 をサボったりしてはいけません。

24. Ask your colleague to introduce the president of your his older brother's company to you.

お兄さんの会社の社長さんを私に ^{しょうかい} 紹介 してください。

25. Ask your friend if he has ever be late for his class.

26. You are staying in Okinawa with friends. Tell them, expecting agreement, that you want to stay here for one more week.

27. You are on a shinkansen with your colleague. Tell him that you are a bit thirsty.
